In 1996, Taco Bell caused a stir with a full-page newspaper ad claiming they bought the Liberty Bell.



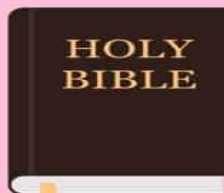
In Scotland it is celebrated for 2 days and is called "Huntigowk Day."
